IAIR 13th Annual General Meeting & Conference 2008

St Petersburg Russian Federation 22-25 June 2008

St Petersburg is a city of sensational architecture, magnificent sculptures, innumerable canals, unique galleries and a colourful history; and we are meeting during the famously known White Nights when it stays light through the night.

The Conference venue, Park Inn Pribaltiyskaya, overlooks the Gulf of Finland; and provides a shuttle service to the City centre, including the world renowned Hermitage Museum.

There will be delegates from some 40 governments from Europe, Africa, Asia, Australasia and North and Latin America, together with representatives from the World Bank and OECD with which the IAIR has been working on the development of regulatory frameworks in the new market and emerging economies. The Conference provides an outstanding opportunity to meet with fellow officials for discussions and exchanges of experiences - both in the formal sessions and during breaks - of current insolvency policy and legislation, regulation and administration and practice issues and initiatives.

- Revenues and user fees

The Form explains how to make payment, either by cheque or direct to the IAIR account. Early registration is essential to ensure sufficient time to arrange for visas to be issued for entry into the Russian Federation.

Visas

The following information is required from all delegates (and their spouses or partners) for the purpose of obtaining a visa for entry into the Russian Federation:

- name of the applicant
- date and place of birth
- gender
- citizenship
- country of residence
- passport number and date of issue, together with its validity (day, month, year)
- dates of travel into and out of Russia, together with the period of stay (days)
- places to be visited in Russia (cities)
- place of issuing visa (city and country)
- place of work (full name of the organisation, address, telephone and fax numbers and position)

You will also need to provide a copy of your passport.

You should send this information to Kirill Kosminskiy, Ministry of Economic Development & Trade, at kosminskiy@economy.gov.ru, and copied to Irina Fomina foir@akm.ru Once the Ministry has all the information listed above, it will make the visa application to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Any inquiries about visas should be made to Mr Kosminskiy.
